ICADTS Foundation Stipend for colleagues working in developing and transitional countries

Goal:

The Stipend is intended to support researchers, students, and workers in the field of traffic safety from developing and transitional countries to attend one ICADTS Conference. Preference should be given to first-time attendees.

Formal conditions:

- The application should be submitted by a person working in related fields of alcohol, drugs and traffic safety.
- Students involved in research projects in the area of alcohol, drugs and traffic safety should be encouraged to apply.
- Recipients of the Stipend will present a report on their participation in the Conference for publication in the *ICADTS REPORTER*.
- If the Stipend is not awarded the Stipend money will stay with the Foundation.

Application:

Application to this Stipend must include the following:

- Curriculum Vitae
- Description of the job and/or research project (not longer than one page A4)
- Calculation of the cost
- Declaration by the applicant's supervisor that the applicant's circumstances are complying with the Stipend's formal conditions
- Declaration by the applicant that he will accept the Stipend's formal conditions and will agree that the decision by the Executive Board of the Foundation is not subject to appeal.

Maximum level of support:

The maximum amount of money to support one recipient is \$ 1000 for a full Stipend. In addition two Stipends may be offered each year to cover registration (maximum \$ 500 each) .

Deadline for submission:

Applications must be forwarded to the ICADTS Secretary (www.icadts.org) before 1st of April of every year in which an ICADTS Conference is to be held.
