Stipends for Young Scientists

The Stipend is intended to help young scientists in different research fields of alcohol, drugs and traffic safety to attend ICADTS conferences.

Formal conditions:

- The application should be submitted by a person (under the age of 36 years) working in related fields of alcohol, drugs or traffic safety.
- Recipients of the Stipend will present (within 30 days after the Conference) a short report on their participation for publication in the Newsletter of ICADTS, *The Reporter*.

Application:

Applicants should submit a request and disclose the following information:

- a) Name of the applicant
- b) Summary of applicant's background, including job description (one page A4)
- c) Details on the cost calculations
- d) Declaration by the applicant's supervisor that alternative funding to attend is not available
- e) A description of how attending the event will help improve the career of the scientist
- f) Whether or not the applicant is a member of ICADTS
- g) Whether or not the applicant is submitting an abstract for the meeting
- h) Whether or not the applicant has attended an ICADTS meeting and whether support has been obtained previously
- Declaration by the applicant that he/she will accept the Stipend's formal conditions and will agree that the decision by the Executive Boards of ICADTS is not subject to appeal.

Maximum level of support: € 1,000.00 (including conference registration fees).
